### n What is Homework Helper?

Homework Helper provides after-school instruction and tutoring support for school-age children in a fun and safe environment.

We use computers, audiovisual materials, and programmed learning to help your children understand their school lessons.

### n How do we do it?

OIC has everything your children need to help them with their school work. We provide age- and level-appropriate learning materials such as books, worksheets, review lessons, and computer software. ### n Who is eligible for Homework Helper?

Homework Helper is open to neighborhood children in grades 1 through 5 and their parents or guardians. Space is limited to 15 children per session.

### n Where and when are Homework Helper classes held?

The OIC Homework Helper program is held at the OIC building located at 500 Maclay Street in Harrisburg. Homework Helper sessions are one day a week for 90 minutes. Days and times will vary. Call us to find out days and times for the months that your children will be attending.
