The Tri-County OIC Learning Opportunities Center is a state-of-the-art computer learning lab. The Learning Opportunities Center features the Comprehensive Competencies Program and the Keys to Work program.

n How can the Center meet my individual needs?

The OIC Learning Opportunities Center offers effective, learner-centered academic instruction using print-based, computer-assisted instruction, audio, visual, and CD-ROM technologies.

Students choose the instructional medium in which they learn best and work at their own pace. A professional facilitator is available to guide learners through their instructional competencies.

n What can students do at the Center?

The Learning Opportunities Center can help students to:

- prepare to take the GED high school equivalency test;
- study for and pass the written portion of the standard Pennsylvania driver's license and the Commercial Driver's License (CDL) examinations;
- improve basic life skills;
- upgrade their basic reading, writing, and math skills;
- improve their employability skills;
- learn functional skills such as parenting, job search, and consumer economics;
- learn keyboarding skills, data base management, computer literacy, and spreadsheet applications; and
- prepare for the ACT and SAT examinations.
